

## Trip itinerary (example)

### **Lima (Peru's capital city)**

**2 days**

Bus tour of the capital city as well as visiting a shanty town on the outskirts where hundreds of people live in extreme poverty, visit Scripture Union Peru's deaf programme and hear about their work. Visit the street boy centre in Lima and take part in a seminar on poverty.

### **Iquitos (Amazonia)**

**3 days**

City tour of Iquitos the largest city in the Peruvian rainforest (it is considered the most populous city in the world that cannot be reached by road). Experience a boat trip to the street boy home in the jungle as well as visiting the shanty town of Belen and seeing firsthand the Vine Trust's medical centre and one of their Amazon Hope ships.

### **Kusi (Peruvian Andes)**

**5 days**

After an 8 hour journey we'll reach Kusi, 2500 metres high in the Peruvian Andes where the group will spend a few days working: making bricks, stripping bamboo, laying foundations and generally helping with the development of street boy homes/buildings. We'll have a trip up to the spectacular Lake Llanganuco situated at a height of 3800 metres.

### **Cusco (Sacred Valley)**

**3 days**

Cusco is the historic capital of the Inca Empire and a World Heritage Site, here we'll see the sights of the Sacred Valley, including a trip to the famous Machu Picchu. We'll visit one of the homes in nearby Urubamba and spend time with the boys.

### **Lima**

**1 day**

On the final day there will be time for buying souvenirs from a local market.
